The 13th Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organization (WTO) was held in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates from 26 February to 2 March 2024. As an original member of the WTO, Macao, China formed a delegation comprising representatives of the Economic and Technological Development Bureau (DSEDT) and the Macao Economic and Trade Office to the World Trade Organization (DECM (OMC)) to attend the Conference, with the DSEDT's Deputy Director Chan Tze Wai serving as the head of delegation. The Ministerial Conference is the WTO's top decision-making body. It is held biannually to review the implementation of WTO agreements and the functioning of the multilateral trading system, as well as make decisions on matters under multilateral trade agreements on a consensus basis.

IFD members convene a special meeting

After intensive negotiations, the Conference reached a number of practical outcomes and issued the Abu Dhabi Ministerial Declaration, in which members pledged to strengthen the multilateral trading system and continue to push forward the reform of the WTO. Concrete outcomes mainly include:

- The Agreement on Investment Facilitation for Development (IFD), responding to the strong aspiration of developing members to attract foreign investment and grow economy;
- 2. The Dispute Settlement Reform Ministerial Decision, striving to restore the normal operations of the dispute settlement system by this year;
- 3. The Work Programme on Electronic Commerce, extending the moratorium on customs duties on electronic transmissions to the 14th Ministerial Conference, which provides a stable rulesbased environment for global digital trade development;

- 4. Realization of the entry into force of the outcomes of negotiations on services domestic regulation to reduce the costs of global services trade;
- 5. Approval of the accession of Comoros and Timor-Leste to the WTO to enhance the representativeness of the multilateral trading system;
- 6. The Ministerial Decision on Smooth Transition Support Measures in Favour of Countries Graduated from the LDC Category to help the relevant countries better integrate into the multilateral trading system.

The Conference also achieved outcomes on regulatory cooperation, small economies, and non-violation and situation complaints, among others.

2. Second meeting of the Guangdong/Macao Expert Group on Cooperation in Technology and Innovation held in Macao

The second meeting of the Guangdong/ Macao Expert Group on Cooperation in Technology and Innovation was held in Macao on 28 February. It was attended by Tai Kip Ip, Director of the Economic and Technological Development Bureau of the Macao Special Administrative Region Government; Wang Yueqin, Director-General of the Department of Science and Technology of Guangdong Province (GDSTC); and Huang Shengbiao, Deputy Director-General of the Economic Affairs Department of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government in the Macao Special Administrative Region, among others.

Director Tai Kin Ip remarked that Guangdong-Macao cooperation is one of the major tasks of the SAR Government for promoting regional cooperation. With the two sides working closely and promoting pragmatically the collaborative development of innovation and technology between Guangdong and Macao over the last year, a certain level of outcomes has been achieved; Director-General Wang Yueqin expressed the hope for the achieving of mutual benefits in the work on Guangdong-Macao technology and innovation in 2024 by means of complementation of advantages under the national strategic background of pursuing high-level technological self-reliance.

At the meeting, representatives of Guangdong and Macao summarized the work of the Expert Group over the past year, introduced the major work plans for 2024 and discussed on enhancing the cooperation between Guangdong and Macao on innovation and technology, among other tasks.

After the meeting, the GDSTC and the Science and Technology Development Fund of Macao (FDCT) signed a cooperation agreement on the Work Plan for Initiating Joint Funding for Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Joint Laboratories. In the future, the two sides will pursue development together by continuing to deepen pragmatically the collaboration projects between the two places.

The meeting was also attended by representatives from, among others, the FDCT; the Education and Youth Development Bureau; the University of Macau; the Macau University of Science and Technology; the Pharmaceutical Administration Bureau; the Macau Post and Telecommunications Bureau; as well as Nansha District of Guangzhou; the Zhuhai Science and Technology Innovation Bureau; the Economic Development Bureau of the Guangdong-Macao Intensive Cooperation Zone in Hengqin, among others.

The Economic and Technological Development Bureau (DSEDT) organized a group of 30, consisting of members of the High-and-New Technology Sector Development Policy Study Group of the Economic Development Council (CDE) and of the Science and Technology Council (CCT), to travel to the Intensive Cooperation Zone (ICZ) on 29 February to visit relevant enterprises and institutions and have in-depth discussions with representatives of government agencies of the ICZ.

Led by Tai Kin Ip, Director of the DSEDT, the group visited Wisewave (Zhuhai) Technology Co., Ltd., Summitview Integrated Circuit Fund and the Traditional Chinese Medicine Science and Technology Industrial Park of Cooperation between Guangdong and Macao to learn about the current development of the high-and-new technology sector and traditional Chinese medicine research and development and manufacturing in the ICZ, as well as to discuss in-depth cooperation between the sectors of Macao and Hengqin.

focuses, as well as the recent implementation of work.
