

Issue 63 of CEPA Newsletter Released

The 63rd Issue of “CEPA Newsletter” has been released. December sees the signing of the CEPA Investment Agreement and CEPA Agreement on Economic and Technical Cooperation between the Ministry of Commerce of the Central People's Government and the Government of the Macao Special Administrative Region at the Government Headquarters, marking a new phase of economic and trade cooperation and exchange between the Mainland and Macao.

Besides, Hong Kong and Macao signed the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and Macao Special Administrative Region Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement during the 10th Hong Kong Macao Cooperation High Level Meeting to facilitate the two SAR governments keeping abreast of the market pulse and foster more collaboration opportunities, favouring the long-term economic development and growth of the two places.

The China-Portuguese Speaking Countries Cooperation and Development Fund (CPDFund) organised the first publicity campaign since its settlement in Macao – the China-Portuguese Speaking Countries Cooperation and Development Fund Promotion Session, which helped to deepen the understanding of the industrial and commercial sector and the public on the CPDFund and at the same time promoted two-way cooperation in investment between China and Portuguese-speaking countries.

To further implement the policy objective of supporting youth innovation and entrepreneurship and provide support services with higher comprehensiveness to young entrepreneurs of Macao, the SAR Government has entrusted Parafuturo de Macau Investment and Development Limited to operate the new Macao Young Entrepreneur Incubation Centre at the 3rd Floor of The Carat, NAPE. The new Incubation Centre will forge an integrated service platform focusing on providing systematic innovation and entrepreneurship support services to youth startups while utilising resources more efficiently.

To actualise the setting up of an “innovation and entrepreneurship exchange centre for young entrepreneurs in China and Portuguese-speaking countries” in Macao, which is a measure advanced by Premier of the State Council Li Keqiang for benefiting Macao, the SAR Government has finalised the setting up of the Youth Innovation and Entrepreneurship Centre for Young Entrepreneurs in China and the Portuguese-speaking Countries, of which the plaque unveiling ceremony was held on 18 October 2017.
