

OCESC Application Procedures Streamlined

To facilitate businesses and citizens to apply for Registration for Controlled External Trade Operations (OCESC) and to achieve full digitalization that will save applicants time from having to visit public authorities, the Economic and Technological Development Bureau (DSED) has streamlined the procedures for application for OCEC from 1st February, 2024.

Starting from today, apart from applying in person at the DSED, applicants can also apply via e-mail or simultaneously with application for electronic customs declaration service platform (EDI). In addition, the documentary requirements have also been simplified to facilitate import and export operators.
