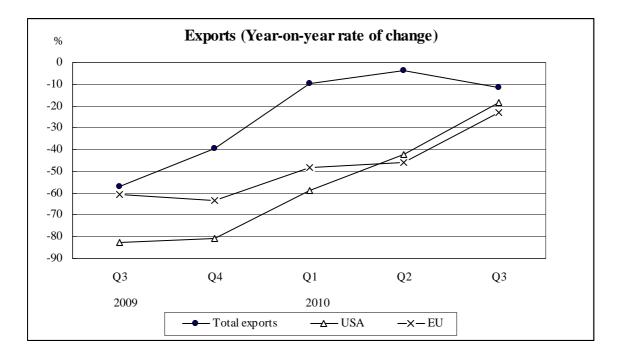
External Trade of Macao in the Third Quarter of 2010 a

Overview

Macao's external merchandise trade showed sustained growth in the third quarter of 2010, with total value of merchandise imports and exports rising by 13.5% to MOP 13.14 billion. Value of merchandise imports rose by 18.3% to MOP 11.48 billion; decrease in merchandise exports widened to 11.6%, amounting to MOP 1.66 billion. The exports-imports ratio dropped further by 4.9 percentage points year-on-year to 14.4%. Trade deficit widened from MOP 7.83 billion in the third quarter of 2009 to MOP 9.83 billion.

Total Exports

Value of merchandise exports to the US (MOP 241.5 million), the EU (MOP 105.5 million), Mainland China (MOP 257.6 million), Hong Kong (MOP 622.2 million) and Vietnam (MOP 41.4 million) decreased by 18.5%, 22.9%, 1.9%, 20.0% and 9.2% respectively; exports to Taiwan, China rose by 5.5% to MOP 35.5 million; value of merchandise exports to Japan held stable as the third quarter of 2009, at MOP 30.5 million. Garment and textile products still predominated as the major merchandise of exports, yet the value shrank by 15.3% to MOP 467.1 million, bringing its relative importance to total exports down to 28.2%. Besides, exports of jewellery, sharing 4.5% of total imports dropped significantly by 68.2%; while exports of machines, apparatus & parts and other products rose by 2.6% and 2.3%, accounting for 6.5% and 60.8% respectively of total exports.

Domestic Exports

In the third quarter of 2010, decline in domestic exports narrowed to 11.4% year-on-year, at MOP 628.8 million, sharing 38.0% of the total exports; quarter-to-quarter, value of domestic exports rose by 10.2%. The US still remained as the largest market of Macao's domestic exports, yet value of exports decreased, at a slower rate, by 26.6% year-on-year. Value of domestic exports to the EU decreased by 21.4%, while that to Hong Kong rose by 6.6%, taking over the EU as the second largest market of Macao's domestic exports. Value of exports of garment, accounting for 51.9% of the total domestic exports, declined further by 23.7%, of which value of exports to the US and the EU dropped by 31.5% and 21.5% respectively to share 54.9% and 27.2% of the total. Value of domestic exports of other products rose by 7.2% to take up 48.1% of the total domestic exports.

Value of domestic exports to Mainland China increased by 15.7% to MOP 62.6 million, accounting for 10.0% of the total; in particular, the value of tariff-free merchandise exported under the Mainland and Macao Closer Economic Partnership Agreement grew by 30.1% to MOP 9.89 million, consisting mainly of copper-clad board (44.7% of total), garment (24.5%), stamps (12.7%) and cement (8.7%); the amount of tariff saved totalled MOP 0.83 million.

In addition, results of the Industrial Exports Survey for the third quarter of 2010 indicated that the average length of time of orders on hand of the interviewed manufacturers stood at 2.63 months, up by 2.3% from 2.57 months in the same quarter of 2009. Meanwhile, 42.5% of the enterprises expressed optimism about the domestic industrial exports in the coming six months, up by 5.1 percentage points quarter-to-quarter and surged by 35.5 percentage points year-on-year, with 6.5% anticipating a substantial increase and 36.0% expecting a modest increase. However, 21.3% expected less promising prospects of exports, down by 4.9 percentage points quarter-to-quarter and 17.4 percentage points year-on-year; moreover, 35.0% expected the outlook of exports remained stagnant, down by 1.0 percentage point quarter-to-quarter and 19.0 percentage points year-on-year. The findings showed that the manufacturers were cautiously optimistic about the outlook of exports.

Re-exports

Value of re-exports amounted to MOP 1.03 billion in the third quarter of 2010, down by 11.7% year-on-year and 17.2% quarter-to-quarter, accounting for 62.0% of total exports. Hong Kong was the largest market of Macao's re-exports, constituting 50.3% of the total, which was followed by Mainland China, at 19.0%. Value of re-exports to Hong Kong dropped notably by 23.9% and that to Mainland China went down by 6.5%.

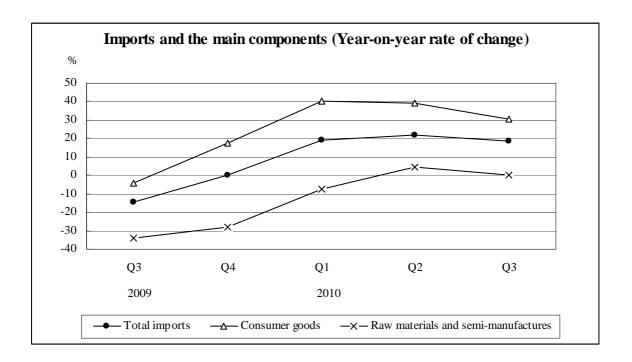
In terms of the types of merchandise, value of re-exports of consumer goods fell substantially

by 30.4% to take up 38.2% of the total, while that of raw materials & semi-manufactures, accounting for 21.4% of the total, increased by 13.0%.

Imports

Value of merchandise imports increased by 18.3% to MOP 11.48 billion in the third quarter of 2010 upon rising imports of consumer goods. Mainland China continued to be the largest supplier of goods imported to Macao and the value of imports rose by 12.6% to MOP 3.62 billion (31.6% of total). Value of imports from the EU (22.4% of total), Hong Kong (10.3%), Japan (8.6%) and the US (6.0%) expanded by 29.7%, 19.1%, 21.4% and 19.7% respectively, while that from Taiwan, China (2.3%) dropped by 11.0%.

Regarding the types of merchandise, value of imports of consumer goods (58.9% of total) soared by 30.4%, capital goods (16.3%) and raw materials & semi-manufactures (12.5%) by 11.9% and 0.2% respectively, whereas that of fuels & lubricants (12.3%) held stable as the third quarter of 2009.
